**Summer Reading
Program Activities**



The following activities are suggestions for students to complete during the summer so they may share their summer reading during the school year. It is recommended that each student complete two activities.

Create a diorama depicting your favorite part of the story.

Construct a mobile of important events and characters from the story.

Conduct a mock interview with a character from the story by composing 10 questions you would like to ask.

Present an oral summary of the story.

Create a personal response journal - record your feelings and reactions to characters in your story.

Fashion a T-Shirt advertising the book and be prepared to give a summary.

Create a computer-generated presentation about your book.

Develop a video of a favorite or 30 second commercial persuading others to read the book.

Create a game, i.e. Jeopardy, Mystery Guest, Crossword Puzzle, board games.

Create a bookmark showing the title, author, main character and a brief summary of the story.

Make a book jacket for the story.

Make a poster about the book using two or more of the following media: paint, crayons, chalk, paper, ink, or other materials.

Construct puppets and background scenery and present a show of one or more interesting parts of the book.

Create a song about your book.

Draw a comic strip of your favorite character or scene.

Write a book review for a newspaper.

Design a post card from one of the characters.

Write and illustrate a poem about the story.

Write a different beginning or ending to your story.

Compare and contrast two characters in the story.
