Barbara Dudley called the subcommittee meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

5442 – Health Assessments / Interscholastic Sports Program – The subcommittee reviewed the policy and regulation. Carol Ott, Health Services Coordinator, recommended several changes after conferring with Athletic Director Chip Dorwin and reviewing state guidelines. Ms. Renner suggested the committee add that the Sports Participation Health Record be “reviewed and filed” in the Health Office. The policy and the regulation will be received at the May Board of Education meeting.

5414 – Suicide Prevention and Intervention – The subcommittee continued the discussion of a draft of proposed changes to the policy and regulation. Mr. Bloss suggested revisions to the wording due to the sensitive nature and potential liability of this policy. Anne Keene will incorporate the revisions and distribute them to the policy subcommittee members and to Ms. Ott. Ms. Ott will also review changes with the School District Medical Advisor. Members were asked to notify Dr. Keene of any questions or suggestions. The subcommittee will consider the revised drafts at the June meeting.

The subcommittee reviewed the CABE sample policies relating to use of Web Tools for Staff and for Students. The subcommittee will continue this discussion at the June meeting. Dr. Keene also distributed policy information packets on cell phone policies and cyberbullying which will also be added to future agendas. Barbara Dudley provided resources on the First Amendment and the Internet that she received at the National School Board Association meeting.

The next policy subcommittee meeting will be Monday, June 28, 2010, at Calvin Leete Elementary School.
