EXECUTIVE SESSION – INTERVIEW POTENTIAL BOE APPLICANTS

Chairman Bloss called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m. Board of Education members present were Keith Bishop, William Bloss, Barbara Dudley, Cynthia Cartier, Louis Iorio, Alan Meyers, Kathleen Nolan and Ted Zuse. Approximately 25 members of the public were also present.

Upon a motion made by Mr. Zuse and seconded by Mrs. Nolan, the Board voted to waive the deadline for application for community members to apply for the Board's vacant seat.

Chairman Bloss invited public comment from those present. Several members of the community spoke on behalf of individual applicants. Public comment was closed.

Upon a motion made by Dr. Meyers and seconded by Mr. Zuse, the Board voted unanimously to go into Executive Session at 7:48 p.m. to individually interview the six applicants.

Upon a motion made by Mr. Bishop and seconded by Dr. Meyers, the Board voted unanimously to return to public session at 11:43 p.m.

Naomi Migliacci was nominated by Dr. Iorio and seconded by Mrs. Cartier.

Douglas Newman was nominated by Mr. Zuse and seconded by Dr. Meyers.


Cheilaugh Garvey was nominated by Mr. Bloss and seconded by Mrs. Nolan.

Upon a motion made by Mrs. Dudley and seconded by Dr. Iorio, the Board voted unanimously to close the nominations.

Ms. Migliacci received five votes (Iorio, Cartier, Bishop, Dudley, Meyers); Mr. Newman received one vote (Zuse); and Ms. Garvey received two votes (Bloss, Nolan). Ms. Migliacci was appointed the 9th member of the BOE for a term to expire in November of 2007.

Upon a motion made by Mrs. Cartier and seconded by Dr. Iorio, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn at 11:47 p.m.
