**1. Call to Order**

William Bloss called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m. Board of Education members present were William Bloss, Keith Bishop, Barbara Dudley, Louis Iorio, Alan Meyers, Naomi Migliacci, Kathleen Nolan, and Ted Zuse. CTFSF members present were Joe Goldberg, Doug Newman, Mauro Rubbo, Andrew Wolek, Larry Gelo and Mary Jo Kestner. Superintendent of Schools Tom Forcella and Director of Operations Jim Saisa were also present.

**2. Discuss Action Step 2 – Facilities Study**

The Board and the Committee discussed the next steps in the process of evaluating the buildings of the district. It was the sense of the two groups that a demographic study of anticipated future trends should be undertaken by the town, and that the BOE should write to the Board of Selectmen and the Board of Finance to seek guidance on the most appropriate process. The two groups also discussed that clarification of the relative roles of town elected and appointed boards and committees in the process of reviewing the facilities should be sought. The two groups agreed that BOE representatives would report to the full BOE regularly about the activities of the CTFSF, and that the two groups would meet together regularly as needed. The BOE agreed to place on its next meeting agenda consideration of authorization of next steps in the process.

**3. Executive Session – Teacher Contract Negotiations**

Upon a motion made by Mrs. Dudley and seconded by Dr. Iorio, the Board voted unanimously to go into Executive Session at 8:00 p.m.

The Board returned to public session at 9:15 p.m. and voted to adjourn.
