United States Constitution:

What is it? The laws of our country

Why it was written? To replace a weaker government

What does it do? It breaks government into 3 parts that share power. Tells us how our government works and our role in it.

Bill of Rights:

What is it? A list of our basic rights like freedom of speech or freedom of religion

Why it was written? **To guarantee our rights**

What does it do? **Protects** the rights of Americans
